GDPR: NO MOBILE PHONES POLICY PHOTOGRAPHY/VIDEO RECORDING ~ INTERNET AND SOCIAL MEDIA



Please note that the school has a **No Mobile Phones in School Policy**, and therefore, unless prior permission has been given, parents/carers are not allowed to use mobile phones or take photographs/videos in school.

There are some children in school who, for security reasons, cannot appear in photographs or video recordings and therefore do not have consent in place for photographs to be taken.

Whilst we want to allow you to record special moments in your children's lives at events organised by school off-site (eg participating in Sports Day, Christmas Concert etc), we must insist that any digital images or recordings taken from cameras and mobile phones do <u>not</u> include pictures of any children other than your own, unless you have asked permission from the parents/carers of the children involved. This includes the sharing of images electronically e.g. via the internet and social media sites.

Flu Immunisations 2024-2025



Your child is due to receive their annual nasal flu vaccination at Lothersdale Primary School on **Tuesday 22 October 2024 at 1pm** and the deadline for completing the online form was yesterday, Thursday 17 October 2024.

Please click on the E-consent link below to complete the form **if you have not already done so**. It is important that this information is collated in advance of the vaccination visit.

For your child to receive their Nasal flu vaccination in school, please complete a YES consent form using the link below. If your child cannot have the Nasal spray, the injectable flu vaccine is available, and you will be able to choose that method on the consent form. If you DO NOT wish for your child to have a flu vaccination, please complete a NO consent via the same link. *Please complete the form even if you do not wish your child to receive the vaccination or if they have received it elsewhere.*


<u>All</u> leave of absence must be requested via the *Pupil Leave of Absence in Exceptional Circumstances During Term Time* form. This form can be found on the school website and should be completed as far in advance as possible and preferably at least 6 weeks before the first date of the period of leave being requested. Please note this also applies to half-days and taking children out of school before the normal end of school day.

Pre-admissions Register of Interest

The school Pre-admissions Register of Interest list for a potential reception place at Lothersdale Primary School is starting to fill up for next year's September 2025 admission group.

It is important that parents/carers register their interest for a reception place for their child as soon as possible (even if you live in the village) to enable us to determine potential numbers and the impact it will have on the future school roll.

Please be aware that entering your child's name on this list does not constitute the offer of a Reception place.
