



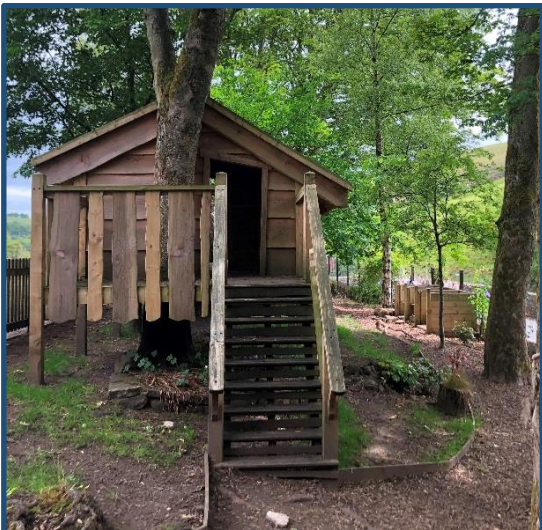
I'M GOING

It is very special to have a Y6 buddy at school!

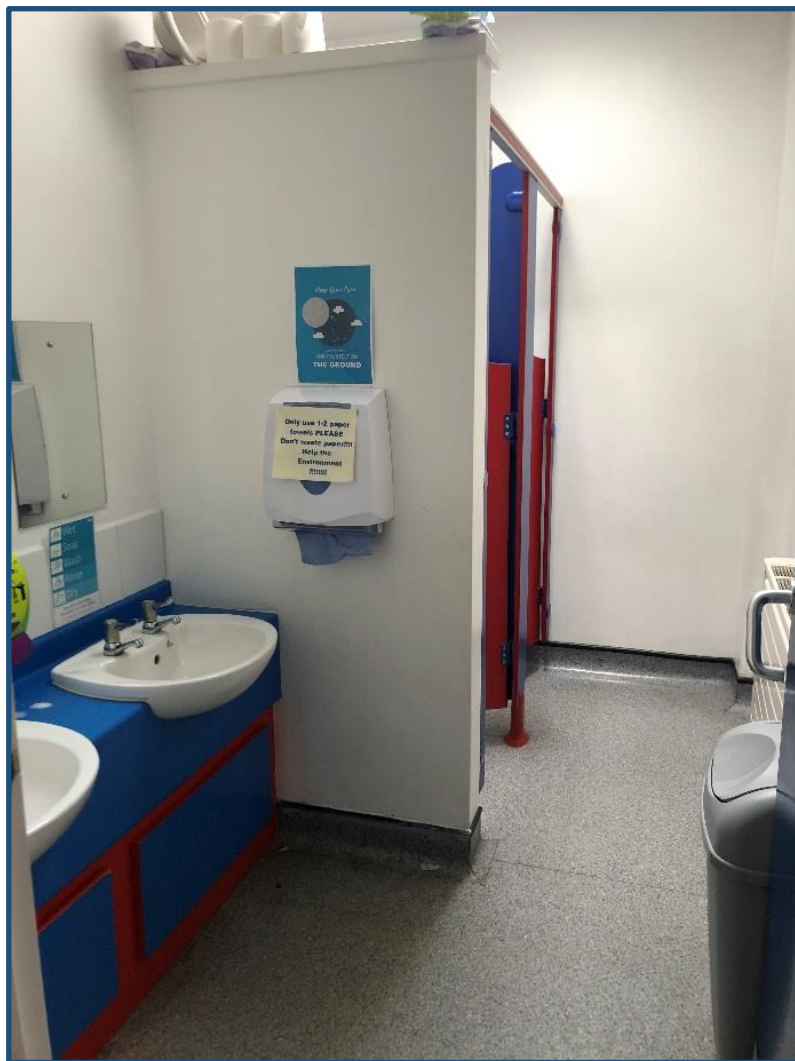
This is my classroom where I

hands (not a noisy hand dryer).



When we are all busy in the classroom, Mrs Bateman and Mrs Gallagher will say ‘wiggle your fingers’ and ‘fold your arms’ and this means we all have to **STOP** what we are doing and listen carefully.



I have my own water bottle in the classroom with my name on it and I can stop and have a drink whenever I am thirsty.

Just before we all go outside to play at 10.45am, I sit down with my friends and eat a piece of fruit and have a carton of milk to drink for snack time (if I do not like milk I can drink my water).



Every day there is a
Special Person in Class 1.

When it is my day to be the Special Person, I can be at the front of the line and do special jobs like taking the register to Mrs Ellison in the school office.



I can also choose to take a friend with me when I go to the office.

Once a week we have P.E. with **Gerry** and this is what he looks like.



Gerry also takes an after-school club called 'Supersports', which is very popular with Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 pupils.

When it is lunchtime, I line up with my friends and I walk to the counter with Mrs Bateman and Mrs Gallagher to collect my lunch.

The older children look after me when I sit at a table to eat my lunch.

She looks after everyone in the
school and makes sure we all stay
safe and happy!
