When I come to school, this is the playground and woodland area where I play and do P.E.








When visitors come to school, this is our main school entrance.



When I come to school in the morning, we line up in the playground in our Class 1 line and then walk into school quietly.

Mrs Ellison works in the school office.



When it is my special day, I might pop in to take a message to her from my teachers. This is where I hang my coat and my P.E. bag.

It is called a 'cloakroom' and I have two pegs with my name on so that I know where to put my things.



I also need to remember my wellies on the days we go to the woods and park!

My class teacher is called Mrs Bateman and this is what she looks like.



Mrs Gallagher and Miss Laycock are our Teaching Assistants who help Mrs Bateman - this is what they look like.





They all make sure I am happy when I am at school.



As well as making lots of new friends in my class, I will have a buddy who is older than me, they will be in Year 6.

At Lothersdale School Y6 buddies really look after us at playtimes. If I am feeling sad, they will play with me. They will read stories to me and will join us when we go to the woods for the first time.



When I need the toilet, I have to ask Mrs Bateman, Mrs Gallagher or Miss Laycock and they will help me go to the toilet.



Can you use the toilet by yourself? Try this at home so you can do it yourself in September.

> The toilets are just outside the classroom so they are easy to get to.

I have to remember to wash my hands really well! I will use paper towels to dry my hands (not a noisy hand dryer).



When we are all busy in the classroom, Mrs Bateman and Mrs Gallagher will say 'wiggle your fingers' and 'fold your arms' and this means we all have to **STOP** what we are doing and listen carefully.



I have my own water bottle in the classroom with my name on it and I can stop and have a drink whenever I am thirsty.

Just before we all go outside to play at 10.45am, I sit down with my friends and eat a piece of fruit and have a carton of milk to drink for snack time (if I do not like milk I can drink my water).



Every day there is a **Special Person** in Class 1.

When it is my day to be the Special Person, I can be at the front of the line and do special jobs like taking the register to Mrs Ellison in the school office.



I can also choose to take a friend with me when I go to the office.

Once a week we have P.E. with **Gerry** and this is what he looks like.



Gerry also takes an after-school club called 'Supersports', which is very popular with Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 pupils. When it is lunchtime, I line up with my friends and I walk to the counter with Mrs Bateman and Mrs Gallagher to collect my lunch.

The older children look after me when I sit at a table to eat my lunch.



My Headteacher is called Mrs Tyson and this is what she looks like.



She looks after everyone in the school and makes sure we all stay safe and happy!
